



5 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT: DREAM & PROMISE ACT

1. THE MOST INCLUSIVE IMMIGRANT BILL YET! The Dream & Promise Act provides protections to immigrant youth as well as communities with Temporary Protected Status (TPS) and Deferred Enforced Departure (DED). That's over 2 million people!

2. PROVIDES A PATHWAY: This bill will, if passed, provide a pathway to citizenship for immigrant youth, TPS and DED holders, who qualify under this bill.

3. POSSIBLE RELIEF FOR DEPORTED COMMUNITY MEMBERS: Immigrant youth, DACA, TPS, DED recipients, who've been deported and who qualify under this act, may apply for relief!

4. WIDER ACCESS TO EDUCATION: This act would provide nationwide in-state tuition access to undocumented folks! It also gives us access to federal financial aid and federal work-study programs.

5. A VISION FOR THE FUTURE WE WANT, NEED AND DESERVE. This bill is a bold step forward for our communities. With it we are making clear that policy to protect immigrant communities can, and must, exist without including anti-immigrant add-ons that would hurt our communities and strengthen Trump's Deportation Force.
